## **POLICY ON THE CONTAINMENT OF THE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS**

As at: 02.07.2020 and UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

### **THE CLUB IS OPEN**

The Club closed from Sunday 22.03.20 to Sunday 03.05.20: we are now open from 6am to 10pm. Special Regulations apply throughout.

#### **1. Monitoring**

- The Club is closely monitoring developments regarding the spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus, and this policy is based on new regulations from the BMA, with advice from the Ministry of the Interior [MOI], the Department of Disease Control (under the Thai Ministry of Public Health [MOPH]), and from the Chief Medical Officer for England (under the UK Department of Health and Social Care).
- The Club was last inspected on 03.06.2020
- The situation is very fluid, and this policy may change at any time.

#### **2. Members (including Members returning from the Absent List)**

- Any Member, or spouse or child or household member who has come from abroad in the past 14 days should follow the advice on this website: [https://ddc.moph.go.th/viralpneumonia/eng/ind\\_traveltoeng.php](https://ddc.moph.go.th/viralpneumonia/eng/ind_traveltoeng.php)
- Any Member, or spouse or child or domestic staff who has influenza symptoms (coughing, sneezing, panting or a runny nose), must seek immediate medical attention, and not come to the Club.
- Upon arrival, all Members and their families and household staff will be individually temperature checked. Anyone 37.5°C and over or refusing to be checked will not gain entry, nor will those who are travelling with them.
- All persons entering the Club shall wear a facemask.
- Staff will record names and membership numbers of all Members entering the Club.  
Entry by foot shall be by the Silom and Surawongse Pedestrian Gates only; Entry by vehicle shall be by the Silom Gate only. Exit (by foot or vehicle) may be by either the Suriwongse Gate or the roadway of the Silom Gate.
- Any Member, or spouse or child or domestic staff attending the Club, who shows any influenza symptoms, will be asked to leave the Club immediately and seek medical attention. Those with them will also be asked to leave to reduce the risk of secondary contagion.

#### **3. Non-Members**

- Reciprocal Members will not be admitted to the Club and all reciprocal clubs have been notified.
- Associated Groups, Loyal Societies and Non-Member players may access the Club in accordance with the By-laws

#### **4. Club Operations**

- The following F&B outlets are open for table service:
  - Poolside: all outlets 6am to 10 pm.
  - Clubhouse: The Churchill Bar 10am to 10pm; The Verandah 11am to 10pm, closed 2pm to 5pm Mon to Thu.
- The following facilities are open:
  - Cricket Nets, Fitness 1 (Cardio), Fitness 2 (Weights), Squash Courts, Tennis Courts, Multi-Purpose Court, Poolside Changing Rooms, Poolside & Clubhouse Toilets and Swimming Pools.
  - Thai Massage is open 10am to 6pm, Friday to Wednesday.
  - There are special regulations in place for the playing of sports and swimming.
- All surfaces within the Club are disinfected regularly in accordance with the BMA regulations.
- All F&B outlets have been remodelled to allow adequate social-spacing.

#### **5. Further Club Temporary Closure**

- If any person connected to the Club is found to be infected with Covid-19 Coronavirus the Club may close for any period of deep cleaning as instructed by the Khet Bangrak Medical Officer or as the MOPH directs, or if in the judgement of the GC such a closure were needed to safeguard the health and well-being of the Members and staff.
- A closure may also be recommended by the Royal Thai Government regulations in any preventative policy to contain the spread of this virus.

#### **6. Staff, contractors & taxi drivers**

- All staff, contractors and taxi drivers will be individually temperature checked upon arrival. Anyone 37.5°C and over or refusing to be checked will not gain entry.
- Any staff member who shows any influenza symptoms, will be asked to seek medical attention.
- Any staff member who becomes infected will be given the fullest support possible, including aid to the family, whilst the staff member is hospitalized.
- No staff member, who at any time, feels uncomfortable in serving a particular member, or spouse or child or domestic staff, who appears ill, shall be at fault. The Club will seek immediate medical treatment to the afflicted person.
